

Botany Community Update

Car Park Waste Encapsulation (CPWE) – Community Consultation

Orica and its contractors Thiess Services are preparing for the cleanup of contaminated soil encapsulated under a car park at the Botany Industrial Park.

Orica is committed to liaising with the community as the CPWE project progresses. The approach towards community consultation was discussed at the March Community Participation and Review Committee (CPRC) meeting.

Key stakeholders such as adjacent neighbouring industry, users of Hensley Athletics Field and nearby residents will be provided with regular and prompt communication during the project. Communication will be via letters, emails and briefings.

Project information will also be shared and discussed with the CPRC. Anyone is welcome to attend CPRC meetings. The CPWE cleanup project will now be discussed as one of the first items at each quarterly meeting to make it easier for people with specific interests in the project to attend.

The wider community will continue to obtain updates via newspaper columns, newsletters, the hotline and the website.

Foreshore Road Monitoring Wells

Progress on Sydney Ports redevelopment works adjacent to Foreshore Road has enabled Orica to commence the replacement of some old monitoring wells and install new monitoring wells. The groundwater wells are being installed over the next few weeks on the southern side of Foreshore Road.

Residential Bore Monitoring

Orica will conduct residential bore testing in mid May. Please call Erika on 9352 2334 by 6 May if you live in the Groundwater Extraction Exclusion Area and would like to have your bore tested.
