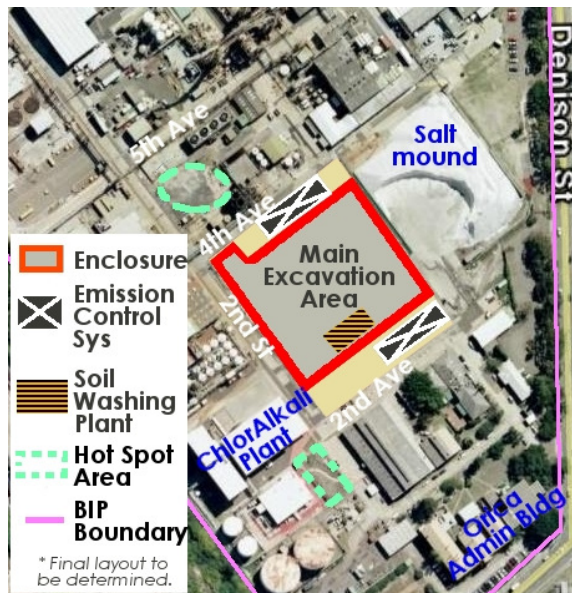
Project Update

- Orica has contracted Highlands Remediation Ltd for the soil washing process only and Thiess Services for remediation services (enclosure, excavation etc)
- Commencement date (target September) dependent on design and construction of plant
- Large temporary enclosure to manage dust and vapour
 - Soil washing plant and main excavation area
 - To be fitted with two emission control systems
 - Stack emissions will be licensed under EPL2148
- Mercury hot spots off main excavation area to be excavated and treated in soil washing plant
- Remediation Action Plan submitted to Site Auditor for review
