Also, the results of the August temperature trial have been finalized and indicate that you are easily satisfying your dioxin licence limit, even at a reduced temperature. With this in mind I wish to put it to the IMC/CLC that:

- (a) the dioxin monitoring be reduced from every 2 months to every 6 months; and
- (b) the plant be allowed to operate at a reduced secondary chamber temperature.
